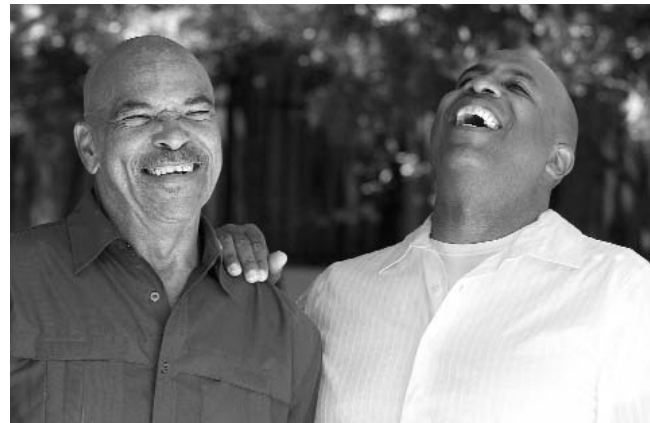

About Aurora Mental Health Center

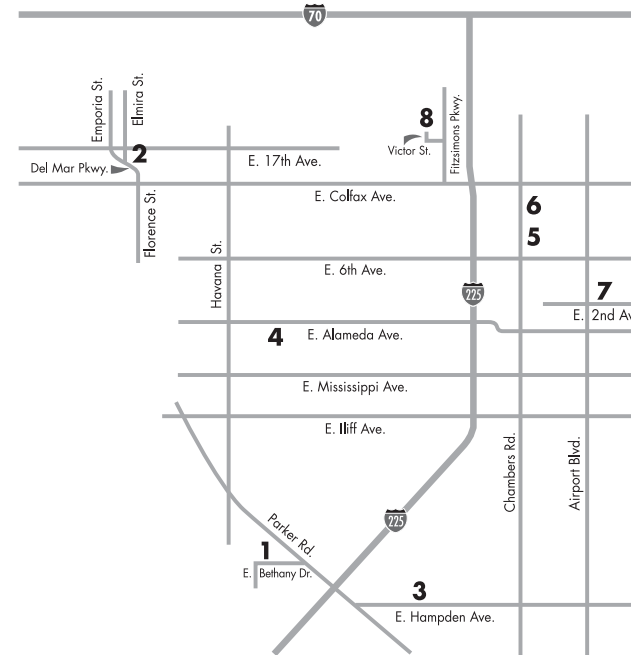

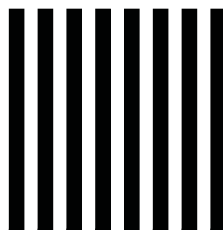

- **People who have untreated mental health issues, such as chronic stress, spend more money on general health services than those who seek mental health care when they need it.**
- **When mental disorders are treated properly, the recovery rate is better than most other illnesses, including heart disease.**

extra guidance on how to cope with emotional issues, we help individuals so they can succeed at work, at home, in relationships, and most importantly, live a balanced life.
